

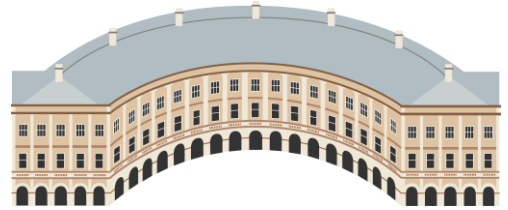
# Learn Buxton venues

## BUXTON CRESCENT

The stunning Grade I listed Georgian crescent-shaped building in the heart of Buxton. Originally containing hotels, lodgings and the famous natural baths, it was built for the 5th Duke of Devonshire as part of his plan to make Buxton a fashionable spa town.

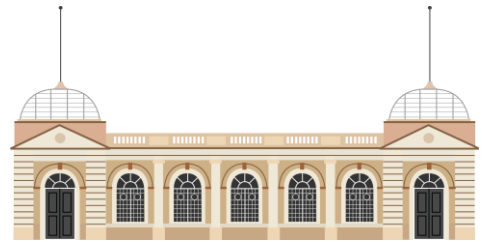

The marble pool inside The Buxton Pump Room is filled by thousands of gallons of the famous Buxton spring water every day. Built for the 7th Duke of Devonshire in 1894, this elegant Grade II listed Victorian Pump Room was (and is once more again!) a haven for people to 'take the waters'.
